Arrangements for Weddings

Planning a wedding is a lovely time and we in the parish want to support you. Sometimes the legal requirements, planning the Service and Church etiquette can be forgotten or neglected in the middle of all the busyness and excitement!

Wedding Mass or Wedding Service? - Celebrating the Sacrament of Marriage does not require the celebration of Eucharist (Mass). In a "mixed" marriage or if the couple and/or a large number of guests are non-Catholic or non-practicing, a Marriage Service is now recommended by the Diocese. If couples wish to have a Wedding Mass, the period of notice is a great opportunity to begin attending Church regularly again.

Civil Weddings - There is a growing trend towards wedding ceremonies in hotels in Ireland. These are invalid in the eyes of the Church. If a catholic contracts an invalid marriage they are excluding themselves from Holy Communion. Couples can have a **Convalidation** ceremony if they wish to return to receiving Holy Communion. Please contact us and we will do our best to help.
