ARRANGEMENT'S FOR WEDDINGS

Planning a wedding is a lovely time and we in the parish want to support you. Sometimes, the legal requirements, planning the Service and Church etiquette can move to the background in the middle of all the busyness and excitement! Paperwork

It is the couple's responsibility to ensure that both the Church and Civil requirements are fulfilled prior to getting married. The parish requires six months notice of intention to marry but it is common practice to book several years in advance. Pre-Marriage Courses

A marriage preparation course provides the couple with some (short) "time out" during their busy wedding preparations. It is an opportunity to focus and reflect on their relationship. Couples **must** attend a course prior to the wedding. Historically, some couples in Aghagallon booked a course and did not attend, or requested a visiting priest to preside at their wedding who did not then insist on following Diocesan procedures. From March 2017, pre-nuptial enquiry forms and notice of marriage forms will only be completed after couples attend a pre-marriage course and furnish the parish with a copy of their certificate of attendance.

Wedding Mass or Wedding Service?

Celebrating the Sacrament of Marriage does not require the celebration of Mass. In a "mixed" marriage, or when a large number of guests are non-Catholic/non-practicing or when a couple themselves are not regularly attending Mass, a Marriage Service is now recommended by the Diocese. If nonpracticing couples wish to have a Wedding Mass, the period of notice of marriage is an opportunity to begin attending Church regularly again.
