A Little Church Dictionary

The Ambo: A lectern in the church sanctuary from which scripture is read and the homily is said during Mass.

The Nave: the central body of the church building, where the pews are located. The word is related to "naval," since the Church is often called the "Barque (boat) of Peter," and in many churches the nave can resemble the wooden beams of an inverted ship.

The Sacristy: A room near the altar, where the clergy vest for ecclesiastical functions. Sacred vessels, vestments and other articles needed for liturgical use are stored in the sacristy.

The Sanctuary: The area around the altar is called the sanctuary; it is a sacred space because of the physical presence of God in the Eucharist, both during the Mass and in the tabernacle on the altar the rest of the time.

The Tabernacle: A tabernacle is a fixed, locked box in which the Eucharist is "reserved" (stored).
