Preparation for sacraments When you asked for your child to be baptised into the Catholic faith, you and their Godparents promised to bring them up in that faith until they were old enough to make their own choices about attending Mass and receiving sacraments. In our Parish we believe Religious Education is a partnership between home, school and the parish. Life can be busy and we know it is a considerable commitment to attend Mass regularly and prepare children for sacraments. To assist you in the preparation for sacraments we have a very special Children's Liturgy during the 11 a.m. Sunday Mass. We hope that all children of primary school age register and attend our Children's Liturgy. Application forms are available in the porch or from one of the Children's Liturgy leaders. If your child is in P3, P4 or P7 and you intend to present them for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, First Holy Communion or Confirmation this year, it is essential that you attend Church regularly with them.
