Induction Loop System helps people who are deaf or have a hearing loss to pick up sounds more clearly by reducing background noise. They work in a particular area when a person’s hearing aid is switched to the ‘I’ setting (or loop programme). This allows them to focus on sounds – such as a person speaking – from the loop system microphone, rather than the internal hearing aid microphone, which normally amplifies all noise in the area. If you have any questions regarding the use of the induction loop system, please contact the parish office.
