

<u>Updated Guidelines:</u> Daily and Sunday Masses: The NI Executive has confirmed that Churches can reopen for public worship on 29th June 2020, provided they can fulfil a number of Health and Safety regulations, guidelines and risk management. Understandably, it may take some time for these measures to be put in place and the Diocese has scheduled meetings with senior priests next week to consider the resumption of public worship and possible issues. It is important to remember that currently, there is no obligation to attend Mass on Sundays or Holy Days and that people who have been asked to shield by their doctor should not be visiting the Church. St Patrick's Aghagallon will resume Mass with a congregation as soon as we can. Masses this week will continue to be celebrated without a congregation. Please join us on the webcam or radio:

St. Patrick's Church is open: The Church is open between 12-2.30pm and 3.30-6pm each day for Private/Personal Prayer. A maximum of 10 people are allowed in the Church at any given time and a one way system is in place, with the main Aghalee Road entrance as the way in. Please ensure that all health and safety advice is followed if you are visiting. The doors are open to ensure the Church is well ventilated.

Funerals: Funeral Services and Requiem Mass in the presence of the deceased and 10 people, whilst observing social distancing regulations, is now permitted across the diocese. Funerals will be streamed for others to watch at home. Prayers at the graveside are restricted to the close family/friends of the deceased, to a maximum of 50 people. Please ensure social distancing advice is followed.

Weddings: From 15th May the NI Executive permitted the solemnisation of Marriages where one of the partners or an immediate family member is terminally ill. Such weddings may take place inside the church and are subject to the restriction of a maximum of 10 persons (including the couple and the celebrant). and with social distancing observed. From 8th June 2020 outdoor weddings in the grounds of the Church, are allowed with no more than 10 people present and with social distancing observed.

Baptisms can only occur if the baby is unwell/awaiting surgery.

**Graveyards** are open. While visiting this Cemetery please protect yourself and others. OBSERVE SOCIAL DISTANCING.

Closures: The playing field and car park remain <u>closed</u> until further notice.

Rosary: Join us via the webcam as we pray the rosary each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 3pm.

Anniversaries: Anniversary/Special Intention Masses will continue to be offered. These can be requested via telephone or email and viewed on the Webcam. We will try to accommodate specific dates requested.
