

Diocesan Guidelines: The Diocese has issued updated guidelines based on the NI Executives restrictions designed to reduce the transmission of Covid-19 within the community. These restrictions will apply from 00.01am on 27th November for a period of 2 weeks and are to be followed by all parishes.

Daily and Sunday Masses: The public celebration of Mass is currently suspended in all Churches within the Diocese for 2 weeks but will continue to be celebrated at the normal times without a congregation in the Church. Services will be streamed on the parish radio and parish webcam. This can be accessed from our website www.aghagallonandballinderryparish.ie. Parishioners will not be able to attend daily or Sunday Masses in the Church.

Funerals: Funeral Services and Requiem Mass in the presence of up to 25 people, whilst observing social distancing regulations is still permitted with no pre or post funeral gatherings. Funerals will continue to be streamed for others to watch at home. Available Times for Requiem Masses in St Patrick's Church, Aghagallon Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday: 10a.m. Tuesday and Thursday: 10a.m. or 12 noon. Sunday: 9a.m. Weddings: Weddings are still permitted in the Church with a maximum of 25 guests – email the parish for more details.

Private Prayer St Patrick's Church will remain open for private personal prayer from 9am – 6pm (except during mass times).

Face coverings are mandatory while entering and leaving the Church. Please use sanitiser and follow all health and safety advice when visiting.

Anniversaries: Anniversary/Special Intention Masses and Sanctuary Lamp Intentions continue to be offered. Currently, they can only be booked by telephoning the office or via email.

Adoration: There will be no adoration for the next 2 weeks, it will resume after restrictions ease.

Confessions: Will cease for a 2 week period, until the current restrictions come to an end.

On Thursday 3rd December between 10am-12 noon and 7.30pm-9pm we will leave the back door into the sacristy open for any families who are in need of these toys to come along and take what you need.
