

Carol Service: Due to the current situation this year we decided to cancel our usual carol service in the church and pre-record a carol service for everyone to enjoy from home. In keeping with the tradition of Christmas jumpers and a fun sing along, the carol service is available on our website today Sunday 13th December 2020 at 6pm. So get your hot chocolate ready and Christmas jumpers on and join us watching musicians, choirs and schools from our parish.

Church Doors We have been advised by the diocese that during the winter months we can close the inside church doors and open the windows for ventilation. The door will stay open until Mass begins to minimise the touching of door handles. During adoration on a Wednesday the inside door will remain closed, can we ask parishioners to use the sanitizer in the porch before touching the door handle and then again in the church after touching the handle, we will provide extra sanitizer on a Wednesday.

Daily and Sunday Mass: Please do not enter the Church if you are feeling unwell. The Church will open again between 9am-6pm each day for Private/Personal Prayer. Please ensure that all health and safety advice is followed and avoid touching surfaces and products, unless absolutely necessary. Toilet facilities will be open during Mass times. We regret that the sacristy will remain closed. There is variable capacity, depending on how many parishioners attend as individuals or as families/households. To ensure there is adequate time for cleaning, we ask you not to arrive at the Church more than 30 minutes prior to Mass beginning and to leave promptly when Mass ends. Please sanitise your hands as you enter and leave the Church and before and after using the Shrines. Always maintain a distance of at least two metres between you and people who are not part of your household. We will be using every third pew for seating, which can accommodate two people with a 2 metre distance, or a full household, who are not required to socially distance. We are required to close the Church when we reach capacity. Please take leaflets/bulletins home with you. Holy Communion will be received from the pews for the time being as we cannot meet the 2m requirement if people were processing down the side aisle. Adoration: Resumes from 10am - 6pm on Wednesday 16th December 2020 Funerals: Funeral Services and Requiem Mass, whilst observing social distancing regulations is permitted with no pre or post funeral gatherings. Please follow social distancing advice. Funerals will also continue to be streamed for others to watch at home. Available Times for Requiem Masses in St Patrick's Church, Aghagallon Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday: 10a.m. Tuesday and Thursday: 10a.m. or 12 noon. Sunday: 9a.m.

Weddings: Weddings are permitted in the Church – email the parish for more details.

Anniversaries: Anniversary/Special Intention Masses and Sanctuary Lamp Intentions continue to be offered. Currently, they can only be booked by telephoning the office or via email.

Sanitising wipes are available inside and outside the door. Please wipe the handles before entering and any surfaces you think necessary inside and repeat before you leave. Please stand in the confessional and try not to touch any of the surfaces while inside.

Face Coverings Face coverings are mandatory while entering and leaving the Church. Church leaders are formally recommending and encouraging the use of face coverings during all Masses and other liturgical celebrations, along with the ongoing maintenance of 2 metre physical distancing. It should however be noted that some people are exempt from the wearing of face coverings, as outlined in public health agency guidance.

Christmas Masses and Prayer Around the Crib



Christmas can be a very special time and parishioners may have traditions and certain Masses they like to attend. Many parishes are cancelling public Masses this Christmas due to concerns around covid-19 compliance. However, we feel that our traditions are even more important this year and we want as many people to celebrate a Christmas liturgy as safely as possible within a Church setting. We need your help to ensure this happens.

<u>Christmas Masses.</u> To comply with Diocesan and Government guidelines, and to ensure everyone is as safe as possible, we have made the decision to run a booking system for our 7pm Christmas Eve Mass and the 9am & 11am Masses on Christmas day. Bookings can <u>only</u> be made by emailing (*parishofaandb@yahoo.co.uk*) or phoning (02892 651 214) the parish office on <u>Tuesday 15th December 2020 between 11am-4pm.</u> NB: Bookings will not be taken at any other time. Availability is limited and will be on a first come first served basis. Multiple bookings are not permitted - please only book for yourself and your immediate family. When you are phoning/emailing please include all the details below:

- 1. Your name
- 2. Your telephone number
- 3. How many people wish to attend within your family or bubble
- 4. If you are able to use the stairs to the gallery
- 5. Your first preference Mass and an alternative preference if you so wish.

We may not be able to accept your booking if the church has reached capacity. The outside speakers will be on for an overflow of parishioners wishing to attend and follow Mass in their cars.

Prayer around the Crib. We have developed a short service around the crib for children, families and adults who cannot attend Mass on Christmas Eve but have watched via the webcam and want to visit the Church. They are very welcome to attend between 7.30pm-9pm. We will have special prayer cards for you to pray at the crib and a Eucharistic Minister will be available at the altar for anyone who would like to receive communion. Santa will be outside organising a socially distanced hot chocolate/cup of tea from our volunteers as you leave the church and to make sure everyone is following our elf and safety guidelines (wearing masks, Christmas jumpers, sanitising hands and keeping 2m apart from others. <u>Please remember</u> to take it straight to the car and get home ASAP, before Santa starts his deliveries (NB gatherings outside your family/bubble are not permitted on church grounds - anyone not following our guidelines will be asked to move on and will automatically be placed on the naughty list this year!).
