



Christmas Masses: Please remember that attendance at all Christmas Masses on 24th/25thDecember is by reservation only and all Masses are fully booked. Outside speakers will be on during Christmas Eve Mass for parishioners wishing to listen to Mass in their cars and receive Holy Communion after 7.30pm.

Christmas Eve: Thursday 24th December at 7pm followed by Prayer around the Crib from 7.30pm

Christmas Day: Friday 25th December at 9am and 11am St Stephens Day: Saturday 26th December at 7pm

Prayer around the Crib. People who are not able to attend Mass on Christmas Eve but still wish to come to the Church are invited to visit the Crib and say a special prayer any time between 7.30pm-9pm on Christmas Eve. Eucharistic Ministers will be available in the Sanctuary area for anyone wishing to receive Holy Communion, consecrated during the Christmas Eve Mass. Santa will be outside organising a socially distanced hot chocolate/cup of tea from as you leave the Church and to make sure everyone is following our elf and safety guidelines (wearing masks and Christmas jumpers, staying in your Christmas bubble, etc. - anyone not following our guidelines will automatically be placed on the naughty list this year!).

Daily and Sunday Mass: Please do not enter the Church if you are feeling unwell. The Church will open again between 9am-6pm each day for Private/Personal Prayer.

The Parish Office will be closed from Tuesday 22nd December 2020 until Tuesday 5th January 2021.

There will be no Bulletin on 27th December 2020 and 3rd January 2021. Please remember that the emergency mobile is for sick calls only.
