

Covid Secure Safety Policies and Procedures: When visiting the Church and during all Liturgies, please continue to observe safety measures, such as good hand hygiene and 2m social distancing.

Face coverings must be worn by everyone while entering and exiting the Church – this is a legal requirement, unless you are exempt. Restrictions are still in place for Baptisms, Weddings and funerals. Please contact the office if you require more details.

New Extension to St. Patrick's Cemetery: We will soon begin work on the new extension to St Patrick's Cemetery. Due to extra planning conditions, overall costs have greatly increased. To ensure the parish is not left with a substantial debt and to assist with the upgrading of associated parish facilities, the Graveyard Committee has agreed to offer 150 pre-purchased grave leases, on a first come first served basis, to fund the work. Parishioners will be able to pre-purchase single graves at a cost of £3000 (£1000 for the grave lease plus a donation of £2000 to pre-purchase the lease) and £5000 for a double grave (£2000 for the lease plus a donation of £3000 to pre-purchase the lease). If we do not reach the quota, the pre-purchased grave leases will be offered to people living outside the parish, who would like to be buried in St Patrick's Cemetery. We will then revert to grave leases only being available for purchase at the time of death. To express an interest in prepurchasing a grave lease in the new extension, please contact the parish office via telephone or email during office hours next week, stating your full name, address, telephone number and whether you would prefer a single or double grave lease. We will then contact you when we are in a position to issue a lease.
