<u>Feast of All Saints:</u> Vigil Mass Tuesday 31st October at 7pm Wednesday 1st November – Mass at 10am <u>Feast of All Souls:</u> Thursday 2nd November – Mass at 7pm

Plenary Indulgences: From noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Communion, and prayed for the Popes intentions can gain one plenary indulgence applicable to the souls of the departed by visiting church and there reciting one Our Father and Apostle's Creed. Following the same conditions, the faithful who visit a cemetery once per day from 1st – 8th November and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable to the Holy Souls. Confessions may be made at any time in the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st-8th November. November Dead Lists: Available for collection now in the Church porch. Please return completed lists via the basket at the weekend Masses or the red post box outside the parochial house. The lists will be placed before the Altar during the month of November and any donations will be used to offer Masses for our beloved dead during the month.

Annual Mass for the Dead: Thursday 16th November at 7pm. During the Mass we will pray for loved ones who have died during the past year. Family members have been issued with invitations. If you do not receive an invitation and wish to include a loved one, please contact the parish office during office hours. Members of the Parish Pastoral Council will meet you at the Church door and give you all the information you need for the Mass. You are welcome to join us in the Café of the Community Centre for a cup of tea after the Mass.

MINISTRY OF WELCOME

Baptisms: Please email the office for a booking form and more details. Baptisms take place the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month directly after 11am Mass and on Thursday evenings at 6pm. At least one month's notice is required, during which parents meet with a member of our Baptismal Team and the family attends the 11am Sunday Mass weekly, prior to the Baptism. Families must also be present at 11am Mass on the morning their child receives the sacrament and be ready to begin immediately after Mass. If families are unable to complete the preparation or attend Mass, the Baptism will be rebooked to a time when they can. A total of 20 people are permitted to attend. Weddings: Wedding guests must continue to follow all guidance and adhere to policies and procedures put in place to ensure the safety of all. Couples must contact Fr Declan six months before the date of their wedding to arrange to complete the necessary paperwork. Couples are also required to attend a pre-marriage course. A Wedding Mass is only offered to those who attend Mass in their parish weekly during the six-month notice of marriage period.
