Summer Schedule for July and August. As the numbers attending Mass usually drops during the months of July and August and staff holidays need to be accommodated, we have decided to run with a summer schedule for weekend Masses and office hours. Visits to the Housebound. Fr Declan will be visiting those who are housebound over the next two weeks. We currently have many parishioners who are sick and/or in hospital and require pastoral care. If you are on the visiting list and have not been at home for three consecutive visits without letting us know, we will assume you no longer wish us to call. If you become housebound again, let us know and we can put you back on the list.

St Patrick's Graveyard Extension. The parish has worked hard and spent extra money to ensure the new lawn style graveyard is as ecofriendly as can be. Artificial grass is not permitted in the graveyard. Please ensure that all grave displays are placed on the headstone base and that nothing is planted or covering the areas that are meant to remain as grass. In the next few weeks, we intend to re-level and reseed some areas. Please remove all artificial grass within the next two weeks and if you wish to retain planters/displays that do not currently fit onto headstone bases, please remove them or the parish will dispose of them to enable the work to take place.

MINISTRY OF WELCOME

Booking Masses, Baptisms and Weddings

Masses can be booked in the sacristy well in advance to ensure your preferred dates are available.

Baptisms At least one month's notice is required. To book a baptism parents/guardians must present the child's long birth certificate, complete the baptism request form, meet with one of our Baptism team and attend weekly Mass during the month prior to the date of the Baptism. If parents cannot commit to the preparation, the Baptism will be rebooked to a later date.

Weddings must be booked by the couple themselves. Couples are required to give at least six months' notice of marriage to ensure the preferred date is available and that there is adequate time to complete all Civil and Church paperwork.
