Prayer and Meditation. To help us take the time to reflect during Holy Week we welcome Bridget back to guide us through prayer and meditation in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, from 9pm-10pm on Wednesday 18th April 2019. Christian meditation must immerse us in the Trinity: we surrender ourselves to the Holy Spirit, the master of prayer, so that he can unite us to Christ and perfect our prayer to the Father.

Christian meditation "engages thought, imagination, emotion, and desire" in prayer. As we seek to use the faculties of the mind to know the Lord, understand his love for us, and to move into deep union with him. Use of the mind "is necessary in order to deepen our convictions of faith, prompt the conversion of our heart, and strengthen our will to follow Christ." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2708) "Lord, what do you want me to do?"
