

Diocesan Pastoral Needs Collection: 20th/21st July: £540.00

VISITING CLERGY PROTOCOLS: The Diocese has clear protocols for Visiting Clergy in line with Standards and Guidance issued by NBSCCCI. (National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland).

Planned Visits: A visiting cleric from outside the Diocese of Down and Connor who wishes to minister here on an *ad hoc* one off basis with advanced prior knowledge, (e.g. a family wedding or baptism, giving a retreat etc.), will be obliged to fill in a visiting priest form prior to the event, present his celebret (priest I.D.) on the occasion of the event and sign the Visitor Register retained in the Sacristy.

The host parish is requested to inform the Diocese of the cleric's known planned visit prior to his arrival and provide: Name of Visiting Cleric, Diocese/Religious order etc of Cleric, Occasion for visit, Date of Occasion/Event, Residence (if remaining in the Diocese for several days).

Unplanned Visits: (e.g. funeral): The cleric is required to phone the parish in advance and present his celebret and sign the Visitor Register in the Sacristy when he arrives.

Celebrets (or equivalent Testimonial Letter or endorsement from Diocese of incardination)

In the interest and welfare of all concerned, the Diocese has adopted a clear position in relation to visiting clergy and a simple and unequivocal way forward - "No Celebret, No Celebration".

Altar Servers: During the holiday period and to comply with Diocesan Safeguarding regulations can we please ask parents to accompany their son/daughter into their sacristy when they are serving and stay with them until two vetted adults are present. Parents should return to the sacristy directly after Mass to collect their child/ren.
