Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion - Communion

Services, led by lay people in the absence of a priest, will take place in the parish between the 9th - 13th September this week. Sacramental Preparation for Children in Non-Catholic **Schools:** Faith development is primarily the responsibility of parents. However, in Aghagallon and Ballinderry parish we try to emphasise the partnership between home, school and Church. If you chose to send your child to a non-Catholic school and would like to present them for First Penance (P3), First Holy Communion (P4) or Confirmation (P7) in the parish this year they must be prepared appropriately. Please contact their teacher to ensure that they are part of a catechetical programme and enrol them in children's liturgy in the parish. If schools do not provide sacramental preparation, the parish can assist with providing classes. Application forms are available in the church porch, complete the form and return it to the parish office before Tuesday 24th September 2019. Parents must attend classes with their children. The Growing In Faith Together (GIFT) programme is a follow up to Confirmation. GIFT will be offered to ALL Year 8 pupils in the Parish and will run in the Community Centre for 5 weeks beginning Monday 7th October 2019. Application forms will be sent out to all the children who were Confirmed in our Parish. If your child was confirmed outside the parish and would like to take part in our GIFT programme come along on the first evening and complete a registration form. We need parent volunteers to help run the programme this year. If you would like to volunteer for the 5 weeks please contact the Parish Office ASAP.
