Anniversaries: Anniversary/Special Intention Masses will continue to be offered. These can be requested via telephone or email and viewed on the Webcam. We will try to accommodate specific dates requested.

Baptisms will cease until further notice, unless the baby is unwell.

Funerals The parish can offer a Funeral Mass in private, prior to the family attending a public committal service. These will be streamed for family and parishioners to watch at home. Prayers at the graveside are restricted to the immediate family/friends of the deceased. Please ensure numbers are kept to a minimum and social distancing advice is followed. If families prefer, they can schedule a public Mass for the deceased when the restrictions are removed.

Cemetery Sunday Please join us via the webcam or parish radio, as we offer Mass in private on Sunday 10th May at 11am in St Patrick's Church, for our beloved dead buried in parish cemeteries. Fr Declan will then visit the cemeteries alone directly after Mass to bless the graves. ONE family member per grave (or two if someone requires assistance) can then collect a special remembrance candle from the Newspaper Kiosk, outside St Patrick's Church, to place on each grave. The candles will only be available after 12 noon. Please ensure that you only touch the candle you are taking and bring your own matches/lighter and Holy Water if you wish to bless the graves. To ensure we do not breach permitted activity please adhere to the following visiting times on Sunday 10th May:

St Patrick's and Magherangaw Cemeteries:

12noon-3pm – a representative from families with graves in the first 1/3rd Sections

3pm-6pm – a representative from families with graves in the middle Sections

6pm-9pm – a representative from families with graves in the final 1/3rd Sections

Please collect your candle from 2pm onwards and visit whenever you wish.

NB: maintain at least 2 metres distance from others and if there are too many people in the graveyard when you arrive, please wait for 10-15 minutes. Other members of your family and friends can visit the cemeteries freely from Monday.
