

**Daily and Sunday Mass**: Currently, there is <u>no obligation to</u> <u>attend Mass on Sundays or Holy Days</u>. Please do not enter the Church if you are feeling unwell. The Church will remain open between 9am-6pm each day for Private/Personal Prayer. We regret that the sacristy remains closed and bathroom facilities are only available during Mass times. Please sanitise your hands as you enter and leave the Church and before and after using the Shrines. Always maintain a distance of at least two metres between you and people who are not part of your household.

**Face Coverings:** The NI Executive has issued new guidance regarding the wearing of face coverings in Churches, effective from 6pm on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> July 2021. The requirement for the wearing of face coverings in places of worship, during acts of worship, has moved from regulations into guidance only. <u>However, face</u> <u>coverings must be worn by all while entering and exiting the</u> <u>Church – this is a legal requirement.</u> For the common good and everyone's wellbeing, the use of a face covering is strongly advised and appreciated while moving about the Church and even when seated. Eucharistic Ministers should continue, to wear face masks when distributing Holy Communion.

**Funerals**: There are still some restrictions in place. The number permitted to attend funerals will be determined following individual risk assessments which will establish variable capacity. While in the Church, everyone must be seated individually, with family or with others who are part of their bubble. Funerals will continue to be streamed for others to watch at home. If you are not part of the funeral congregation, please do not gather on Church grounds for the duration of the funeral and burial.

**Baptism:** Baptisms are permitted within strict guidelines. Please email the office for a booking form and more details. Baptisms take place the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month at 12 noon, with only one child/family per allocated Sunday. Baptisms are also available on Thursday evenings at 6pm. **Weddings:** Weddings are permitted in the Church under strict guidelines. Following recent changes to the Health Protection Regulations the number permitted to attend weddings is to be determined following individual risk assessments. Whilst on church property attendees must follow guidance and adhere to policies and procedures put in place to ensure the safety of all. All couples must contact Fr Declan six months before the date of their wedding to arrange to complete the necessary paperwork. Couples are also required to attend a pre-marriage course. A Wedding Mass is only offered to those who attend Mass here regularly.

If many of your guests are non-Catholic and cannot receive the Eucharist, or if you and the majority of your guests are not regularly practicing Catholics, then a Wedding Service is more appropriate. If you have not been practicing your faith for some time and still wish to have a Wedding Mass, the six month notice of marriage is a great opportunity for you to return to Sunday Mass. It is important that you make the choice where, when and how you marry each other and that you are clear about the responsibilities your choice entails.
