

Covid Secure Safety Policies and Procedures: When visiting the Church and during all Liturgies, please continue to observe safety measures, such as good hand hygiene and 2m social distancing. **LEPRA:** Over 7 million people are currently affected by leprosy across the world. Over 4 million people are living with a lifechanging disability caused by leprosy. Although curable, many people are unable to access treatment, even though the cure is free. Lepra works to find, treat and rehabilitate these hidden people and promote their rights in India, Bangladesh and Zimbabwe. Help us beat leprosy – even the smallest contribution can help treat and rehabilitate people trapped by this disease. Envelopes are available in the church porch, these can be left in the collection boxes within the church.
