The Capuchin Day Centre for Homeless People, Dublin: Every person needs to belong and have a place where they are respected and have their basic needs met in a caring and non-judgemental way, for most people this place is called home. Sadly some people must spend their days trying to find shelter from the weather, a place to rest and prepare before going out to face the day. Without security or safety, basic needs are a daily struggle and many people lack what most of us take for granted. While this is tragic for adults, it is heart breaking for families with children who are forced to move from place to place with no stable living conditions. This year instead of sleeping bags we will be collecting new socks and underwear for men, women and children. **New items only** can be left in the church porch by 28th November.

Shoebox Appeal for Romania Shoebox Appeal 2021: The Missionaries of Charity help people on the margins of society as well as running residential units and supporting the homeless and families in the poorer villages surrounding Bucharest.
