

Covid Secure Safety Policies and Procedures: When visiting the Church and during all Liturgies, please continue to observe safety measures, such as good hand hygiene and 2m social distancing. Face coverings must be worn by everyone while entering and exiting the Church – this is a legal requirement, unless you are exempt. Restrictions are still in place for Baptisms, Weddings and funerals. Please contact the office if you require more details. Anniversary/Special Intention Masses and Sanctuary Lamp Intentions. Please book via email or telephoning the office. Plenary Indulgences: From noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the Popes intentions can gain one plenary indulgence applicable only to the souls of the departed by visiting church and there reciting one Our Father and Apostle's Creed. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the aforementioned conditions once per day from 1st-8th November. Confessions may be made at any time in the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st-8th November.

New Extension to St. Patrick's Cemetery: Following advice from the diocese The Graveyard Committee has agreed to offer prepurchased grave leases, on a first come first served basis, to fund the work. Parishioners can pre-purchase single graves at a reduced cost of £1500 and £3000 for a double grave. If we do not reach the quota prior to the end of November, the pre-purchased grave leases will be offered to people living outside the parish. If we do not raise the funds, we will be unable to proceed with the work and the parish will have no graveyard. To express an interest in pre-purchasing a grave lease in the new extension, please contact the parish office via telephone or email during office hours next week, stating your full name, address, telephone number and whether you would prefer a single or double grave lease. We will then contact you if we are in a position to issue a lease. If you have previously registered your details, we will contact you over the coming days to update your request. A six-month payment plan is available to spread the cost.
