Within our Church community it is about making our Church a safe, welcoming and enriching place and is a shared community responsibility in which each and every one of us has a part to play, whether that is reporting a concern about a child or adult or by simply volunteering in your parish in any of our safeguarding activities. Our Parish Safeguarding Committee oversee the volunteers working alongside children and adults at risk of harm ensuring that all volunteers have been vetted and have undertaken the necessary training. Annual audits are completed to ensure that all areas of safeguarding are up to date, adhered to and areas of improvement highlighted. In addition regular meetings are held to discuss all matters in connection with safeguarding in the parish and what can be done to raise awareness about keeping everyone safe.
