

Obligation to attend Sunday/Holyday Masses: Mass on Sunday and Holydays is once again deemed to be an obligation. Parish Office Opening Hours: Interim office opening hours remain Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, from 9am-5pm

First Friday Visits: Currently, monthly visits to parishioners who are housebound take place upon request. We are aware that many people who were previously on the First Friday visiting list have not requested a visit. From September onwards, we are hoping to return to more regular home visits to parishioners who are housebound and/or still shielding. Unfortunately, we will not be able to return to the pre-pandemic levels of monthly visitation when Fr Declan visited 8-10 people each day across the First Friday week. We are developing a blended model of visitation, with Eucharistic Ministers and members of our parish visitation group assisting. This means that not everyone will receive a monthly visit from a priest unless they require a sick call or are going into hospital for scheduled surgery. If you or a family member would like to register for home visits, please contact the parish office next week during office hours and leave your details.

Baptisms: Please email the office for a booking form and more details. Baptisms take place the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3rd Sunday of the month at 12 noon and on Thursday evenings at 6pm. At least one month's notice is required, during which parents meet with a member of our Baptismal Team and the family attends the 11am Sunday Mass weekly, prior to the Baptism. If families are unable to complete the preparation or attend Mass, the Baptism will be rebooked to a time when they can. A total of 20 people are permitted to attend.

Weddings: Wedding guests must continue to follow all guidance and adhere to policies and procedures put in place to ensure the safety of all. Couples must contact Fr Declan six months before the date of their wedding to arrange to complete the necessary paperwork. Couples are also required to attend a pre-marriage course. A Wedding Mass is only offered to those who attend Mass in the parish *weekly* during the six-month notice of marriage period.
