Summer Schedule

During the months of July and August we will have a Liturgy of the Word (Prayer Service led by lay people with Communion consecrated at a previous Mass) on a Monday at 10am, Wednesday at 10am and Friday at 10am. There will be no Masses during the week. Weekend Masses will remain the same during July. August to be confirmed depending on attendance during July.

Adoration will continue on a Wednesday from 10am-6pm. There will be no adoration from 8pm-10pm.

It will be closed for staff annual leave from Tuesday 15th July and re-open on Tuesday 29th July 2025.

Booking Masses, Baptisms and Weddings As parish office opening hours have been reduced slightly, we are returning to our previous practice of booking Masses, baptisms and weddings in person, in the sacristy after Masses.

Masses can be booked well in advance to ensure your preferred dates are available.

Baptisms can only be booked by the child's parent or legal guardian. At least one month's notice is required. To book a baptism parents must present the child's long birth certificate, complete the baptism request form, meet with one of our Baptism team and attend weekly Mass during the month prior to the date of the Baptism

Weddings can be booked by the couple themselves. Couples are required to give at least six months' notice of marriage to ensure the preferred date is available and that there is adequate time to complete all Civil and Church paperwork.
